




3a. Actuals as Compared to Approved, as reported by RPT



5b. Dual credit students with an IEP as reported by the RPT, 2012-13 through 2016-17





Dual Credit Students Who Left the School and Returned, RPT and Province, 2012-13 through 2016-17







8. Overall retention rate, as reported by RPT, 2012-13 through 2016-17






9. Overall success rates as reported by the RPT, 2012-13 through 2016-17

Success Rates for Dual Credit Programs, RPT and Province, 2012-13 through 2016-17




9a. Number of student in RPT achieving each of the following grade categories in their dual credit courses, 2016-17 OnSIS data
