School College Work Initiative (SCWI) / Dual Credit programs are programs approved by the Ministry of Education that allow students, while they are still in secondary school, to take college courses that count towards both their Ontario Secondary School Diploma (OSSD) and a postsecondary certificate, diploma, or degree, or a Certificate of Apprenticeship. Regional Planning Teams (RPTs) may submit proposals for Level 1 apprenticeship in-school training; however, OYAP students **must have Registered Training Agreements (RTAs)** to be eligible for Ministry of Advanced Education and Skills Development (MAESD) seat purchase.
